Weddings at the Driftwood Spars...

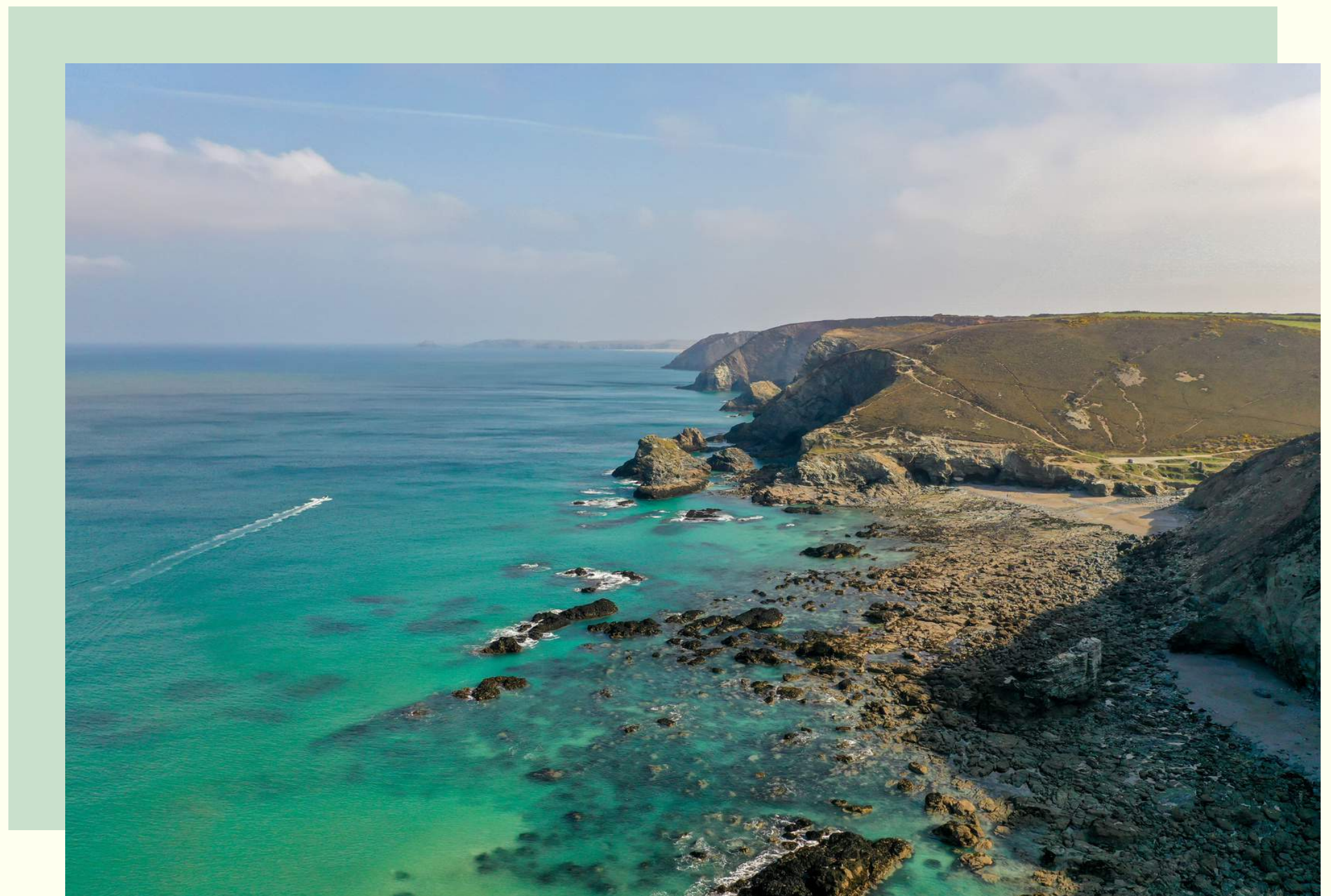

The Sea-View Dining Room

With its wide, open windows, the Sea View Dining room is the perfect space for your celebrations! This diverse area offers a light, bright atmosphere with a perfect view of the sea throughout your day and is therefore perfect for ceremonies, drinks receptions, wedding breakfast meals, and evening parties.

We can seat up to eighty-three guests during your day dependant on whether you have a top table or not but will always welcome up to one-hundred and twenty guests for the evening party! We would not want anyone missing out! The Driftwood Spars is also a fully licensed venue, so we are happy for you to hire a live band or DJ until midnight, as well as other entertainment such as photo booths or roulette tables.

The Cliffside Garden

Built with nothing but the open sea behind it, our newly licenced, hand-made oak structure is the perfect place to say your vows, with eighty plus guests watching on. Decorated already with cliffside lights, fairy lights and foliage, all the Garden needs is your unique touch.

As your day progresses, we can transform this stunning location around, ready for your evening events, with tables, chairs, and our very own pop-up bar. Supplied with our very own Driftwood Ales, a Lager and Cider on tap, this bar will be yours to use through the day and late into the evening.





This is also a great space to set up garden games to keep children or adults entertained. Guests can return to the garden to watch the sun go down while the dinning room is transformed for your evening party.

With access to sockets as well as surround sound speakers, you can have the choice of your own playlist or a live band to dance the night away to.



Our Fishing Loft

Situated in the heart of our pub, The Fishing Loft Bar is a room with a wealth of character! Built in the 16th Century, the Driftwood has strived to keep its rustic charm, from the original beams to the stone walls. Available to hire throughout your day, it can serve as your private bar, for smaller gatherings or your ceremony room.

Our Micro Brewery

The Driftwood Spars Brewery was founded in 2000 and is joined with The Driftwood Spars — a unique and characterful pub loved by locals and visitors alike, which overlooks the dramatic and beautiful Cornish coastline here at Trevaunance Cove.

The brewery is a five barrel plant and we brew in small batches, allowing us great control over the quality and consistency of our beers. All our beers are gluten free and many are also vegan. We use premium British malts and source the finest hops; we are increasingly using new-wave English hops as new varieties are developed and perfected.

We are proud to have received many awards for our beers over the years, particularly the Champion Winter Beer of Great Britain 2012, awarded by CAMRA for Alfie's Revenge.

Accommodation

We can offer 15 en-suite rooms, sleeping 38+ people, with a variety of views including sea view & garden facing. We provide fresh milk and homemade, gluten free brownies into each room upon arrival, while all of our rates include a hearty & delicious Cornish breakfast served between 8 & 9.30am.

All rooms include crisp linen sheets & soft eider down duvet along with a TV, telephone, tea & coffee making facilities, shampoos, shower gel & a hair dryer.

As soon as your wedding is confirmed, we block off all the rooms we have available for your guests.







Additional Information

Our maximum number of guests for a sit down meal with a top table is 76 and without a top table is 83.

We have a minimum spend on Fridays & Saturdays May– September which is £6,500. In April & October this is £5,500.

The Driftwood Spars offers a diverse space which can be used in multiple ways. So if you are able to pop by, it would be lovely to discuss any wedding ideas with a cup of tea over looking the Atlantic ocean, in our magical setting.
